Membership Information

Membership is open to everyone who supports and agrees with our purpose statement. All members must pay an annual membership fee; agree to follow the guidelines and by-laws of the Guild and to assist with fundraising and events.

If their work is sold by the Guild in their Gallery (physical location or on-line) the Member agrees to pay the Guild a 10% Commission from the sale(s).

Types of Membership

Supporting Member - paid membership and non-exhibiting. This person may be interested in the arts but is not a practicing artist.

Artisan (Exhibiting) Member - paid membership. May exhibit work in the Online Gallery, at Guild sponsored events or tent. Eligible work includes 3D sculpture, paintings - all mediums, pastels, drawings, printmaking, mixed media, photography (no computer art), pottery (handmade), jewelry (handmade), textiles, and glass art. No commercially created items. All artists' work exhibited by the Guild must be 'Family Friendly'. When Artisan (Exhibiting) member's work is sold by the Guild in the Online Gallery or a Guild sponsored event or tent, the Member agrees to pay the Guild a 10% commission fee from the sale(s).

Family Member - paid membership. May or may not be exhibiting. Dues cover all family members residing in the same household. If exhibiting all conditions apply as stated in supporting, artisan (exhibiting) or student categories for each family member.

Student Member - paid membership and can be non-exhibiting or exhibiting. When Student (Exhibiting) member's work is sold by the Guild in the Online Gallery or a Guild sponsored event or tent, the Student agrees to pay the Guild a 10% commission fee for the sale(s). Students under the age of 18 must also have an agreement signed by Parent or Legal Guardian and provide a copy of current school identification card.
